PUBLIC BUILDING SERVICE - THREE PHASE

APPLICABILITY:

Applicable to all electric services of a single character supplied at one point of delivery and used by schools, churches, and community buildings where the member contracts for a demand of not less than seventy-six (76) kilowatts. This schedule is not applicable to temporary, breakdown, standby, supplementary, resale, shared service, seasonal loads, or loads not meeting the conditions of service contained therein.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Alternating current, 60 cycles, three phase at available voltages.

RATE:

Service Charge - \$25.00 per month
 Demand Charge - \$15.00 per month per kW billing
 Energy Charge - 7.343 cents per kWh

ENERGY COST ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE:

The above rate shall be increased or decreased in accordance with Schedule 11-ECA as it currently exists or may be amended from time to time.

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE:

The minimum monthly charge shall be the highest of the following charges:

1. Billing demand charge but not less than \$1,140.00.
2. 75 cents per kVA transformer capacity.

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DETERMINATION OF DEMAND:

The billing demand shall be determined by measurement, and shall be the highest demand indicated during any 30-minute period during the billing period, but not less than 80% of the highest billing capacity during the previous peak season of July and August. When the indicated demand results in a fraction, the nearest unit kilowatt shall be used; that is fractions of 0.5 or less will be dropped and fractions of 0.6 or more will be considered one unit.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

1. If it is necessary to make extensions or to reinforce distribution lines to provide service, the minimum monthly charge will be determined in accordance with the Line Extension Policy as set forth in the Bylaws and Policies.
2. Both power and lighting shall be billed at the foregoing rate. If a separate meter is required for the lighting circuit, the registration of the two watt-hour meters shall be added to obtain total kilowatt hours used and the registrations of the two demand meters shall be added to obtain the total kilowatt demand for billing purposes.
3. If service is furnished at secondary voltage, the delivery point shall be the metering point unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, poles, lines, and appurtenances on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the customer.
4. If service is furnished at Cooperative's primary line voltage, the delivery point shall be the point of attachment of Cooperative's primary line to customer's transformer structure unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, poles, lines, and appurtenances (except metering equipment) on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the customer.
5. If service is furnished at primary voltage, with the customer owning the substation equipment serving the installation, a discount of three percent (3%) shall apply to the total monthly bill as determined by the rates set forth in this schedule, and if the minimum monthly bill is based on transformer capacity, a discount of three percent (3%) shall also apply to the minimum monthly bill. However, the Cooperative shall have the option of metering at secondary voltages, in which case no discount will be applicable.

TERMS OF PAYMENT AND SERVICE:

Terms of payment and service hereunder is subject to the Cooperative's Bylaws and Policies. Payment is due as specified on the billing.

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
