The cooperative's bylaws, rules and regulations are supplemental to this tariff and are incorporated herein.

TOTAL ELECTRIC SERVICE

APPLICABILITY:

Applicable to all electric services of a single character supplied at one point of delivery where electric service is the only permanent source of space heating energy for the dwelling. If the member meets the above qualifications, this would not preclude them from using wood burning fireplaces, solar, and other renewable sources for the production of heat. This schedule is not applicable to temporary, breakdown, standby, supplementary, resale, shared service, seasonal loads, or loads not meeting the conditions of service contained therein.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Alternating current, 60 cycles, single phase and three phase, at available voltages.

RATE:

Usage from October 1 through April 30

- Service Charge \$15.00 per month
- Energy Charge
 - First 750 kWh 11.227 cents per kWh
 - Over 750 kWh 10.227 cents per kWh

Usage from May 1 through September 30

- Service Charge \$15.00 per month
- Energy Charge 12.227 cents per kWh

ENERGY COST ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE:

The above rate shall be increased or decreased in accordance with Schedule 11-ECA as it currently exists or may be amended from time to time.

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE:

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$15.00 where 10 kVA or less of transformer capacity is required. Each member who requires more than 10 kVA of transformer capacity shall pay, in addition to the above minimum, 75 cents per month for each additional kVA or fraction thereof required.

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CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

- 1. Service under this schedule is limited to loads not in excess of 75 kW (100 horsepower motor). If the demand exceeds 75 kW during the peak season months of July and August, the applicable schedule will apply until July 1, the beginning of the following peak season. Demand shall be determined by demand instruments or a demand meter. Demand, when determined by a demand meter, will be the maximum kilowatt demand indicated in any 30-minute interval during the billing period. When the arithmetic total or indicated demand results in a fraction, the nearest unit kilowatt shall be used; that is, fractions of 0.5 or less will be dropped and fractions of 0.6 or more will be considered one unit.
- 2. If it is necessary to make extensions or to reinforce distribution lines to provide service, the minimum monthly charge will be determined in accordance with the Line Extension Policy as set forth in the Bylaws and Policies.

TERMS OF PAYMENT AND SERVICE:

Terms of payment and service hereunder is subject to the Cooperative's Bylaws and Policies. Payment is due as specified on the billing.
